Sovereign Insurance Consortium

- CCCU institutions who joined the consortium in 2019 saved between \$94,000 and \$152,000 annually compared to their 2018 costs.

Online Education Partnership with CampusEDU

- Through the CCCU, CampusEDU works directly with campuses to create state-of-the-art online courses.

Online Course Sharing Network Through Acadeum

- A network of 100+ faith-based institutions offering more than 5,000 online courses, resulting in more than \$26M in recovered revenue for institutions.

Tuition Waiver Exchange Program (TWEPE)

- Faculty members, staff and administrators can send their dependents to participating institutions, receiving a waiver of the institution's usual tuitions.
